General Information

Adult Secondary Education (ASE)

Basic Education, High School Diploma, GED, CAHSEE Prep must bring official transcripts from previous high school to make an appointment with counselor.

English as a Second Language

Assessment and class level placement are necessary for enrollment. Please contact the office for an appointment.

Free Career/Technical Education (CTE) Courses - perspective student must pre-register, attend an orientation and provide all of the following: proof of age=18 or older; photo ID with name; Social Security card; high school diploma or GED; proof of Selective Service Registration (males only); address verification; and proof of transportation to class and training site. For a pre-registration packet and an orientation appointment, come to the Adult Education office.

The Fontana Adult School serves persons 18 years of age or older who wish to continue or complete their education.

High School Students must see their high school counselor prior to enrollment.
