- Pulled Resolution No. 09-41.
- During Closed Session an MOU regarding voluntary transfers (RIFs) was agreed to by the District and USW.
- During Closed Session an MOU regarding Temporary Revisions to Article 8 was agreed to by the District and FTA.
- Held a Public Hearing for the initial proposal by the Police Officers Association for collective bargaining.
- Held a Public Hearing for the initial proposal by the United Steelworkers for collective bargaining.
- Approved entering into a partnership with Cisco for the purpose of enhancing education through the deployment of innovative technology solutions.
- Approved a Memorandum of Understanding with the City of Fontana for Jurupa Hills High School to contribute to the various (street, sidewalk, curb, gutter, etc.) infrastructure needs that will be used by the public, staff and students in accessing the school.
- Approved a Memorandum of Understanding with the City of Fontana for Citrus High School to contribute to the various (street, sidewalk, curb, gutter, etc.) infrastructure needs that will be used by the public, staff and students in accessing the school.
- Approved contract with James Cook to provide Division of the State Architect (DSA) inspection services for Citrus Continuation High School Project Phase I & II.
- Approved contract with Leighton Consulting Inc. to provide soils and materials laboratory testing and special inspection services for Citrus Continuation High School Project Phase I & II.
- Denied the petitions to establish the Community Harvest Foundation Fontana Prep Middle School and Fontana Prep High School charter schools.
- Approved a Memorandum of Understanding with University of California Riverside to provide undergraduate students to tutor FUSD math students at the four comprehensive high schools.
- Approved payment to employees for attending professional and staff development group trainings as specified in Reference FF of the agenda.
- Promoted Mark Olay, Teacher at Kaiser High School, to Athletic Director at Kaiser High School and Therese Kennedy, Teacher on Assignment, to Coordinator, Career Technical Instruction.

Good News

Randy Basset, FUSD's Chief Technology Officer, and Kyle Larrick, Account Manager at Cisco, presented information to the Board on the District's partnership with Cisco. Through this partnership, Cisco will be donating six of their life-sized, high definition video and spatial audio TelePresence units to FUSD: a 6-user unit for the District Office, and 18-user units for each of our comprehensive high schools. These units can be used for collaboration between school sites, connections between classrooms, professional development, Career Technical Education, and virtual field trips, to name just a few possibilities. The equipment and services the District will receive from Cisco is valued in excess of \$2,249,476.48.
