ADOPTION OF AGENDA

The Agenda was adopted with the following changes: Reference O was pulled and change to Classified Personnel Recommendations (Work Experience Student).

MINUTES OF PREVIOUS MEETING

Approved the September 16, 2009 and September 21, 2009 meeting minutes.

RECOGNITIONS/PRESENTATIONS

Sergio Flores, Principal of Fontana High School, gave a presentation to the Board on "My Access," the software purchased by the school to improve student writing.

DISCUSSION/ACTION SESSION

Appointed Mark Olay, Athletic Director at Kaiser HS, as a 2009-10 California Interscholastic Federation (CIF) Representative to League.

Approved entering into a contract with Action Learning Systems (ALS), Inc. to provide SB472 trainings in the amount of \$520,000 for school teachers, effective 11/1/09 through 6/30/10.

Approved findings of the Administrative Hearing Panel.

Accepted presentation on the new school attendance boundaries.

Adopted Resolution No. 09-44, Revision No. 2, utilizing the Network Integration Company Partners, Inc. d.b.a. NIC Partners California Multiple Award Schedules (CMAS) Contract Numbers for electronic data processing goods and services needed through 6/30/10.

Approved the application and related certifications necessary to retain eligibility for SB1777 funding under the 2009-10 Class Size Reduction Operations Funding Program.

Awarded the following bids:

- Bid No. 09/10-1315, Pest Control Services as follows: (a) Bid Item #1 – Gopher and Ground Squirrel Control at 45 sites, at a monthly rate of \$1,577 to ABBA Termite & Pest Control; (b) Bid Item #2 – Rodent Bait Stations at 6 sites, at a monthly rate of \$300 to New Century Pest Control; (c) Bid Item #3 – Fly Control at ROP/Adult School, at a monthly rate of \$500 to New Century Pest Control; (d) Bid Item #4a – Live Animal Trapping/Disposal, at the per incident rate of \$250 to New Century Pest Control; (e) Bid Item #4b – Dead Animal Removal & Odor Treatment at all sites as needed, at the per incident rate of \$65 to Dewey Pest Control, for a total estimated cost of \$34,000.

- N o. 08/09-1311, Purchase of Custodial Supplies for Warehouse Stock, to the lowest responsible, responding bidders as indicated on attached Schedule "B" and Pricing Summary for a total estimated cost of \$317,000 for the remainder of the 2009-10 school year.

Approved Change Order No. 1 to the contract with R. Jensen Company, Inc. for Sequoia MS Relocatables Project, increase of \$3,179.82, new contract sum \$117,079.82.

Approved submission of a Variable Waiver renewal request to the California Commission on Teacher Credentialing for Tonya A. Medway, Language, Speech & Hearing Specialist, Special Services.
