

Graduate Level Semester Units University of San Diego



The option to earn five graduate level semester units for Year 1 and Year 2 of BTSA participation is available for beginning teachers.

Registration & cost:

- The cost is \$60 per unit (\$300) and must be paid by the participant to the university at the time of registration.
- The registration period is September 1, 2009 through May 1, 2010.

Coursework and assignments for Beginning Teachers:

- In order to receive 5 units, the beginning teacher must complete the requirements for Year 1 or 2 of the induction program.
- There are no classes to attend or papers to write; however the teacher must meet weekly for 1 hour with the Support Provider.
- Grades are determined through completion & submission of the following: Expectation/Completion FACT Modules Document, Sources of Evidence Standard 5-6 Check Off forms (Your Support Provider will submit these forms for you) and Portfolio Reviews.

All work is submitted to Anne-Marie Cabrales by the end of June 2010. Anne-Marie submits grades to the University of San Diego. Grade reports are mailed directly to the participants with instructions on how to obtain official transcripts from the university.
