Subject: Postponement of Opening of Summit High School

Dear Parent/Guardian:

On April 6, 2005 the Governing Board of the Fontana Unified School District took action to postpone the opening of Summit High School until the Summer session of 2006. This action was necessary as a result of delays in the school construction process caused by the unusually severe winter weather and other factors.

You reside in an area that has been affected by this change. Our records show that your 9<sup>th</sup> grade student was scheduled to attend 10<sup>th</sup> grade at the new Summit High School. As a result of the Governing Board's action, your student will remain at their current school for the completion of their high school experience. If, for some unrelated reason, you wish to request a transfer for your student, you will need to contact the Child Welfare and Attendance Office to request an intra-district transfer. This office can be reached by phone at 909-357-7095.

Counseling and registration information for your student for the 2005-2006 school year will be completed at the current school of residence. The Summit staff will be working diligently to ensure that every student is properly registered.

This decision has been made to ensure the health and safety of all students and to provide a complete educational experience for each student. We regret any inconvenience which may have been caused by this change but we are convinced that it is the best decision for our students.
