Subject: Postponement of Opening of Summit High School

Dear Parent/Guardian:

On April 6, 2005 the Governing Board of the Fontana Unified School District took action to postpone the opening of Summit High School until the Summer session of 2006. This action was necessary as a result of delays in the school construction process caused by the unusually severe winter weather and other factors.

You reside in an area that has been affected by this change. Our records show that your 8<sup>th</sup> grade student was scheduled to attend 9<sup>th</sup> grade at Summit High School. As a result of the Governing Board's action, your student will be assigned to A. B. Miller High School as a 9<sup>th</sup> grade student for the year 2005-2006. All current 8<sup>th</sup> grade students who were to attend Summit High School have been assigned to A.B. Miller High School for the 2005-2006 school year. This will allow them to enjoy a safe and complete high school program while making friendships and bonding with future Summit High School students and staff. All students will be fully integrated into the comprehensive program at A. B. Miller High School for the 2005-2006 school year, including extra-curricular activities and athletic programs.

Counseling and registration information for your student will be sent to the A.B. Miller High School counseling staff. The Summit staff will be working diligently to ensure that every student is properly registered at A.B. Miller High School. Students should receive class schedules and orientation information for A.B. Miller High School in August, 2005.

In the early spring of 2006 you will receive information from counselors and administrative staff regarding your registration for Summit High School in the fall of 2006. Your student will also have an opportunity to register for Summer School at the Summit High School campus should he/she desire to do so. Summit High School will open for grades 9 and 10 beginning with the summer session of 2006.

Mr. Micheal Andrus, Principal of Summit High School, would like to assure parents and students that this unfortunate delay will be used to ensure a safe and secure environment for students and that planning for an outstanding program will continue throughout the coming months.
