Subject: Postponement of Opening of Summit High School

Dear Parent/Guardian:

On April 6, 2005 the Governing Board of the Fontana Unified School District took action to postpone the opening of Summit High School until the Summer session of 2006. This action was necessary as a result of delays in the school construction process caused by the unusually severe winter weather and other factors.

You reside in an area that has been affected by this change. Our records show that your 9th grade student was scheduled to attend 10th grade at A.B. Miller High School as a result of the new boundaries. The action taken by the Governing Board includes a provision allowing your student to remain at Fontana High School this is your preference. Because your student has attended Fontana High School for grade 9, he/she will be offered the opportunity to remain at Fontana High School to complete his/her high school program. If, for some unrelated reason, you wish to request a transfer for your student, you will need to contact the Child Welfare and Attendance Office to request an intra-district transfer. This office can be reached by phone at 909-357-7095.

Counseling and registration information for those students remaining at Fontana High School for the 2005-2006 school year will be completed at Fontana High School. The Fontana High School staff will be working diligently to ensure that every student is properly registered. If you wish to be assigned to A.B. Miller High School, staff will arrange a counseling and registration opportunity for you. Please be sure to return the attached survey so that we will know your preference for school assignment.

This decision has been made to ensure the health and safety of all students and to provide a complete educational experience for each student. We regret any inconvenience which may have been caused by this change but we are convinced that it is the best decision for our students.
