- Apply as early as October of senior year.





Program Benefits:

- 1. Waiver of enrollment fees (\$46 per unit). Eligible students for the Chaffey College Panther Promise will receive a waiver of all enrollment fees after applying for financial aid.






PREPARING FOR 4-YEAR COLLEGE A-G REQUIREMENTS

A: 2 years	History and Social Science
B: 4 years	English
C: 3 years (4 years. rec. for both)	Mathematics (IM1, IM2, IM3, Adv Math)
D: 2 years: PP (3 years. rec. for UC)	Laboratory Science (1 year of biological science and 1 year of physical science)
E: 2 years: PP (3 years. rec. for UC)	Foreign language (both years must be in the same language)
F:1 year:	Visual and performing arts: art, dance, theatre/drama, or music
G:1 year:	Elective chosen from the subject areas listed above or other college preparatory course (2 semesters or 1 year-long course)

C- or better grade in ALL classes.





NCAA REQUIREMENTS

If you want to play at the NCAA Division 1 or 2 level, make sure you qualify academically so you can participate athletically.

COLLEGE ADMISSION CRITERIA



GPA (Grade Point Average)/Class Rank

Colleges consider a student's GPA in college prep courses to be the most important admissions criteria.



Strength of Subjects

Colleges examine high school transcripts and look for advanced and honors courses.



Test Scores (CSU and UC have suspended requirement)

Most 4-year CA colleges do require students to submit ACT or SAT scores. Private and Out of State schools may require.



Extracurricular Activities

Colleges are interested in seeing meaningful involvement, focus and commitment, evidence of leadership and unique interests or talents.



Recommendations

Colleges often ask for letters of recommendation from counselors and teachers, scholarships also generally require them.

TYPE OF COLLEGE

- 2 Year Community Colleges offer affordable career programs. Students can also start at a 2 yr. college and then transfer to a 4 yr. college
- 4 Year Colleges are either public or private. Public colleges are generally larger and less expensive

SIZE AND LOCATION

 Colleges vary in size-small colleges are more personal; larger colleges offer more programs and majors.

 All colleges offer a variety of majors, however you must find a college that offers the major you are interested in.






















<u>CSU</u>

The California State University (CSU) no longer uses ACT or SAT examinations in determining admission eligibility.



<u>UC</u>

UC will not consider SAT or ACT test scores when making admissions decisions or awarding scholarships.



PRIVATE & OUT-OF-STATE SCHOOLS

Testing for Private schools & out of state schools vary and may be required. See your counselor if you need help deciding if you should test or not.

UNIVERSITY OF CALIFORNIA (UC)

- Must complete the A G requirements
- Accepts the top 9% of high school graduates
- Applications are now open
- Application opened August 1, 2023, and can be submitted from October 1-November 30th.
- Requires Personal Insight Essays
- There are 9 UC Campuses
- Full average cost of attendance is approximately \$37,000. per year \$13-14,000 in tuition only)

UC PERSONAL INSIGHT QUESTIONS

Here are some important points about the personal insight questions:





Freshman applicants will choose four out of eight questions to answer.



Each response is limited to a maximum of 350 words.



All questions will have equal value in the admissions selection process. For applicants, there is no advantage or disadvantage to choosing certain questions over others.

CALIFORNIA STATE UNIVERSITY (CSU)

- Must complete the A G requirements.
- SAT and ACT Will not be used in admission decisions.
- Accepts the top 33% of high school graduates
- Apply Oct 1- November 30* of senior year.
- There are 23 CSU campuses
- 4-Year degrees (BA,BS) as well as graduate degrees.
- Average cost of attendance is approximately \$26,000 per year (\$7-\$9,000 in tuition only)

Now use MULTIPLE measures:
I.E. Senior Year Math & English class placement, Grades, CAASPP scores, SAT, ACT, and AP Scores.



It's important to continue with a rigorous schedule in senior year and maintain the classes you put on your college application.

PRIVATE COLLEGES/UNIVERSITIES

- **Programs:** Associate, Bachelor of Arts/Science, Credentials, Masters, Doctorate.
- Requirements: High School Diploma, GPA varies with each college, SAT/ACT, some need letters of rec., extracurricular activities.
- Final Cost: Tuition, Fees, and Financial Aid varies (Low-High)
- Helpful Tips: Application Open/Close dates vary, use <u>Common</u>

 <u>App</u> and the schools' websites for applications.
- Historically Black College Common App
- Constantly check your student portal, emails, and specific deadlines.

FEE WAIVERS



CSU Application fee is \$70 UC Application fee is \$70 Both applications have built-in fee-waivers. Financial information is asked, then student can submit to see if they qualify.

Private schools have options for the application fee to be waived depending on the school and the circumstances.

Sometimes just filling out the application online will waive the fee.

Grades matter BOTH semesters of your senior year! C's or higher!!!

Admission can be rescinded/taken away the summer after senior year, if grades fall below A-G requirements.



Create a professional email

Check your student portal for each school applied to, student email account, and pay attention to anything you receive in the mail or emails.

Your Counselor will have a handout for you during your senior meeting and information posted on TEAMS with all the information you need to apply to college!





 <u>Application</u> December and submit by April 2,
 2024*
- Counselors will be in classes October 30 November 3 to help you complete your electronic signature (FSA ID)
- Parent/Student Financial Aid Night will be Tuesday, October 24, 6PM MPR Understanding what it is.
- These applications help determine if you are eligible for FREE Money, reduced interest student loans, and work study.
