Fontana Unified Bio Animatronic Students to Receive Prosthetic Arm Demonstration

In 2015, Garner Holt created a new prosthetic arm for Durr; dubbed 'Lefty,' the arm is made entirely out of proprietary silicone, is layered and textured to look realistic, has a rotating wrist, flesh tones and freckles, and can lock in 11 different positions. Durr, who lost her left arm after cancer surgery in 2002 and for years wore a wooden arm, highlights her story in the illustrated children's book, "Grandma's Amazing Arm: The Adventures of Malia Mouse," published in 2015.
