### YOU HAVE RIGHTS

You have rights under the U.S. Constitution and other laws. All people in the U.S. - whether citizens or non-citizens - have certain rights under the U.S. Constitution and other laws.

- STOP** You have the right to refuse to answer the immigration officer's questions until you speak to a lawyer.
- Have the right to stop** You have the right to refuse to answer the immigration officer's questions until you speak to a lawyer.
- Speak to an attorney** You have the right to speak to an attorney before answering any questions. You can stop answering questions until you speak to an attorney.
- Do not have to sign anything** You do not have to sign anything that you do not understand.
- Right to a copy of all papers** You have the right to a copy of all your immigration papers.

#### KNOW YOUR RIGHTS: WHAT TO DO IF IMMIGRATION OR THE POLICE COME TO YOUR DOOR

- STOP AND THINK TWICE WHEN SOMEONE COMES TO YOUR DOOR**  
You're not normally required to open the door to officers, immigration and the police don't come into your home without a warrant signed by a judge.
- REMAIN SILENT**  
You have the right to remain silent. Immigration can use anything you say against you.
- STAY CALM AND DO NOT RUN**  
Use your phone to take photos and video about the raid, but stay calm and do not run.
- ASK TO SPEAK TO YOUR ATTORNEY AND THINK TWICE BEFORE SIGNING ANYTHING**  
Do not sign forms you don't understand or don't want to sign. A lawyer will bring deportation defense may be able to help you fight your case.
