

**Jurupa Hills High School International
Baccalaureate Diploma Program
Admission Policy**

We have a recommended criterion based on GPA and Lexile and Quantile scores, which is only meant to be a guide. This criterion was created based on the successes of other full DP and Course candidates. If the student does not fit into the criterion when they register with their counselor, they will need to make an appointment with the coordinator who will speak with the student about the rigors and expectations of the course/programme.

Recommended criterion:

Singular course candidates:

These students can challenge themselves by taking 1-2 IB courses during their Junior or Senior Year. These students should have an interest or curiosity in the subject they are taking.

With a GPA of 3.0 minimum and a Lexile level of 1150 minimum.

Course candidates:

These students will take 3 IB courses over the course of their Junior and Senior year and 1 of the courses must be an HL level course to achieve course candidate status.

With a GPA of 3.0 minimum and a Lexile level of 1230 minimum.

Associate Diploma Candidates:

These students will take 4 IB courses over their Junior and Senior year and 2 of the 4 IB courses must be HL level courses to achieve course candidate status.

With a GPA of 3.0 minimum, a Lexile level of 1230 & Quantile level of 1000 minimum.

Full DP:

These students will take over the course of their Junior and Senior year 3 SL courses and 3 HL course not to exceed 4 HL course. They will also complete the core requirements of TOK, CAS and Extended Essay.

With a GPA of 3.5 minimum, a Lexile level of 1270 and a Quantile level of 1200

Additional requirements for certain subjects are in place, so students are able to understand the concepts being taught in the DP, i.e. Math and Science. If a student earned a low grade in English, Language B subjects, or History, they meet with the IBDP coordinator to discuss the rigors of the class and are admitted upon this discussion.

We also send the following letter home when a student is identified as a possible full Diploma Candidate.

Dear Parent/Guardian,

Congratulations! Your son/daughter is eligible to become an IB Diploma Candidate for the upcoming school year because of your student's outstanding academic achievement. This program is a prestigious program that is only offered to our highest level of students. The International Baccalaureate Program is a rigorous honors program that, if completed successfully, leads to the IB Diploma, an internationally acclaimed educational achievement. Over the course of two years, students will be enrolled in six courses total to complete the full Diploma Program. Three courses are higher level (two-year) and three are standard level (one-year). Detailed information concerning specific courses will be provided during the registration process.

In addition to the rigors of the academic coursework, IB Diploma students are also required to complete Creativity, Action and Service (CAS) requirements. The approximate 150 hours are to be completed by April of their senior year. Additional support is provided by the IB Core Seminar teacher, who is also the CAS Coordinator on campus. The second core component is the Extended Essay (EE) research paper. The EE is a research paper of the student's choosing. At approximately 4,000 words, this paper is extremely elaborate and time consuming. Students complete this journey with the assistance and guidance of a student-selected mentor. This process is completed over a two year time span, guided by myself. The third component of the core is Theory of Knowledge (TOK). This class is held zero period. Additional information concerning the requirements of the core components are available on the Jurupa Hills and IB websites.

Further information about the thoroughness, requirements and general information concerning the IB Diploma Programme are located online, the address is www.ibo.org. The site includes pertinent information including college requirements and admission information, overall university policies and the specific requirements of the IB Diploma.

The benefits of participation in the IB program are plentiful. Based on a global perspective, students are educated using critical thinking strategies, realistic research and collaborative exploration. These are all qualities universities look for in their applicants.

Felicidades! Su hijo/hija es elegible para convertirse en un candidato para el Diploma IB (Bachillerato Internacional, por sus siglas en Inglés) para el año escolar por el logro académico sobresaliente de su estudiante. Este programa es un programa prestigioso que es solo ofrecido a nuestro nivel más alto de estudiantes. El Programa de Bachillerato Internacional es un programa de honores riguroso que, si es completado exitosamente, lleva a el Diploma IB, un logro educativo aclamado internacionalmente. En el transcurso de dos años, los estudiantes serán inscritos en seis cursos en total para completar el Programa de Diploma completo. Tres cursos son de nivel más alto (dos años) y tres son a nivel estándar (un año). Información detallada sobre los cursos específicos será proveída durante el proceso de inscripción.

Además de lo riguroso del curso académico, los estudiantes del Diploma IB también requieren de completar los requisitos de Creatividad, Acción y Servicio (CAS, por sus siglas en Inglés). Las aproximadas 150 horas deben de ser completadas en Abril de su último año. Apoyo adicional es proveído por Tanya Salazar, quien es la Coordinadora de CAS en la escuela. El Segundo componente central es el trabajo de investigación de composición extendida (EE, por sus siglas en Inglés). El EE es un trabajo de investigación de la elección del estudiante. Con aproximadamente 4,000 palabras, este trabajo es extremadamente elaborado y toma bastante tiempo. Los estudiantes completan este papeleo con la ayuda y dirección de un mentor seleccionado por el estudiante. Este proceso es completado durante el lapso de dos años, guiados por mi. El tercer componente central es Teoría del Conocimiento (TOK, por sus siglas en Inglés). Esta clase se lleva a cabo una vez por semana, por cuatro horas. Información adicional referente a los requisitos de los componentes centrales están disponibles en el sitio web de IB y Jurupa Hills.

Admissions Requirements for Incoming Freshmen into the IB MYP Program

GPA Requirement: Students need to have a Grade Point Average (GPA) of 3.5 or higher. This indicates consistent academic achievement above average.

Lexile Level Requirement: A Lexile level of 1000 or higher is required. This score measures the student's reading ability and suggests they can comprehend complex texts suitable for high school level.

Option for Partial Honors Enrollment:

Admissions Requirements for Sophomores into the IB MYP Program

Students continuing in the Full MYP Program in their 10th grade year must complete their 9th grade classes with C's or better.

Students wanting to challenge themselves and join the Full MYP Honors program need to have a minimum 3.5 GPA and Lexile score of 1000 or higher during their freshman year.
