- Etc...



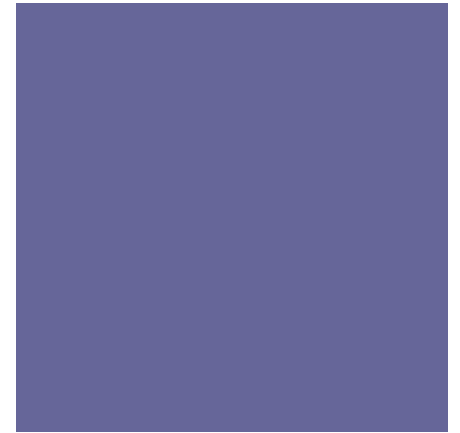
Describe your organizations

Be sure to add pictures of you doing the work to make it visually appealing.





Describe the Project and Duties (Next several slides)



- Describe your responsibilities (example: at Kaiser Permanente), service projects, and outline what you did each day
- Include pictures of you completing the tasks not pics from the internet.
- You should make a new slide for each project
 - Ex: learning how to check in patients, taking blood pressure, checking height and weight.
- You do not need to have everything written on the slides...less words, but be prepared to elaborate during your presentation
- Use the words as a guide...you do not need to memorize, but you should be prepared to add details in your own words



Skills that You learned

- Describe the skills that you learned from each of the service projects
- What did you gain from each project (not just “actual skills,” but personal as well)
- Be reflective!!
- How did these projects help you grow?

+ Challenges



- Describe the challenges you faced when completing the project
- Describe what you learned by facing these challenges



Project Value/Personal Benefits



- Use the following slides to describe why the projects were valuable and describe the personal benefits you received by participating in the project.
- What did you learn about yourself?
- How did you grow?
- How did you feel?
- How does this impact your life?

+ Conclusion



- Use this slide to conclude your presentation
- Briefly summarize the overall challenges/benefits
- Thank everyone for participating in your panel
- Ask for questions

+ ADVICE for Presentation



- Be sure to include pictures throughout your presentation to make it visually interesting! Pictures of you in action not off the internet.
- Practice, Practice, Practice!!!
- Time yourself to see if you are within the designated time (3- 5 minutes)
