GRADUATION GUIDELINES CLASS OF 2020

No Contact Safe Graduation

Individual Ceremony and Graduation Filming

The Individual Ceremony and Filming will take place at Ontario International Airport.

- Each graduate will be allowed to bring up to 1 vehicle (type of vehicle is attached).
- **No** additional vehicles will be permitted.
- Graduates need to wear their cap, gown and tassel to the airport.
- All individuals in the vehicle must wear masks.

Vehicles will enter Ontario International Airport through the Terminal 2.

- Cones will guide graduates and families to the staging area.
- Each graduate needs to place their name on their dashboard on the passenger side.
- Pop Up Tents will be stationed along the road. As cars proceed to the terminal, they will stop and receive a graduation bag with a commemorative mask and other items. The graduate needs to replace their personal mask with the commemorative mask.

To ensure a smooth graduation please do the following

- Arrive at the ceremony at the time designated by the school. The graduates need to check with their high school to see what time they should report to the ceremony.
- Ensure the graduate is in the front passenger seat for easy drop off. If the graduate is the only person in the vehicle, the graduate will be allowed to park and participate in the ceremony.
- Place the name of the graduate on the dashboard on the passenger side.
- Graduates need to wear flats or wedges as they will be walking on grass. *Please, no high heels.*

Vehicles will be guided to the "Runway". The parent/guardian/drive will be asked to stop at a "gate". The graduate will exit the vehicle and be filmed as they receive their diploma and take a photo with their principal. Family members may take pictures from their vehicle but may **NOT** exit the vehicle. A professional photographer will take the graduates picture (Information regarding the photo is in the graduation bag).

The ceremony will be broadcasted <u>live (Please see schedule below)</u> A YouTube link will be provided to the Class of 2020 and their families prior to the viewing time.

Ceremony

During the ceremony, the graduate and their family will proceed through East Terminal Way enter the runway. The ceremony will consist of

- Patriotic Song
- Principal's Welcome
- Student Speeches
- Presentation of the Class of 2020
- Acceptance of the Class of 2020

<u>Issuance of Diploma</u>

- The parent/guardian/driver of the graduate will be guided to park at a designated area by a staff member.
- As the graduate exits the vehicle, their name will be called and will proceed to
 the stage to have their photo taken. Only the graduate may exit the vehicle. If
 the graduate is only driver in the vehicle, they will be allowed to park and exit
 the vehicle to participate in the ceremony. Families may take pictures from the
 vehicles.

Professional Photo

- The graduate will exit the vehicle with their Boarding Pass.
- The graduate will:
 - Walk on stage.
 - Receive their diploma cover.

- Turn their tassel
- o Have their photo taken by a professional photographer.
- The graduate will then enter the vehicle and exit the airport.


Quick Step & Checkoff List:

- Graduates families are limited to **one** vehicle.
- Waiver has been signed.
- All occupants have face masks.
- Graduate is dressed in cap, gown and tassel and is seated on the passenger seat. No high heels; flats and wedges only.
- Name of graduate is placed on passenger side of dashboard.
- Graduate stops and picks up graduation bag with Boarding Pass as they enter the airport.
- Graduate replaces personal mask with Commemorative Mask.
- Graduate has name card ready to hand to the announcer and will exit the vehicle with mask on and have their name called.
- Graduate will proceed to a staging area to collect the diploma jacket and take a picture with their principal/dignitary.
- Graduate will enter vehicle and exit the airport.
