Make a list of tallest to shortest.</p>	<p>Make a card for a firefighter, hospital worker, police officer, or service provider and thank them for helping to keep us safe. Have an adult help you find an address and mail the letter to a worker helping in our community.</p>	<p>Count how many windows and outlets are in your home. Which one has more/less?</p>	<p>Make a timeline of your life – starting with the day you were born</p>
