Draw and label the characters of a book you are reading.	Find an object around the house beginning with every letter of the alphabet.	Write or draw about something fun you like to do at home.	Count how many forks and spoons are in your house. Which one has the most/least?
Write about a character who goes on an adventure. Where did they go? What happened?	Staple or fold pieces of paper together to make a book. Write and illustrate a story to share with your family or class.	Free Reading – 20 minutes.	How many combinations of numbers make 10? Write down all the ways you can make 10.
Measure how tall each person in your family is using blocks or can. Make a list of tallest to shortest.	Make a card for a firefighter, hospital worker, police officer, or service provider and thank them for helping to keep us safe. Have an adult help you find an address and mail the letter to a worker helping in our community.	Count how many windows and outlets are in your home. Which one has more/less?	Make a timeline of your life – starting with the day you were born
Do some PE activities by dancing, playing outside, or exercising with your parents' permission.	Play a board game with your family.	Design your dream bedroom. Draw and label your design.	Skip count by 1s, 5s, and 10s to 120.
Find 5 rectangles in your home. Draw a picture of each item.	Write 6 of your sight words on the sidewalk with chalk. Have an adult take a picture of you by your words.	Write a math problem about your family.	How many shapes do you know? Draw and label as many shapes as you can.
