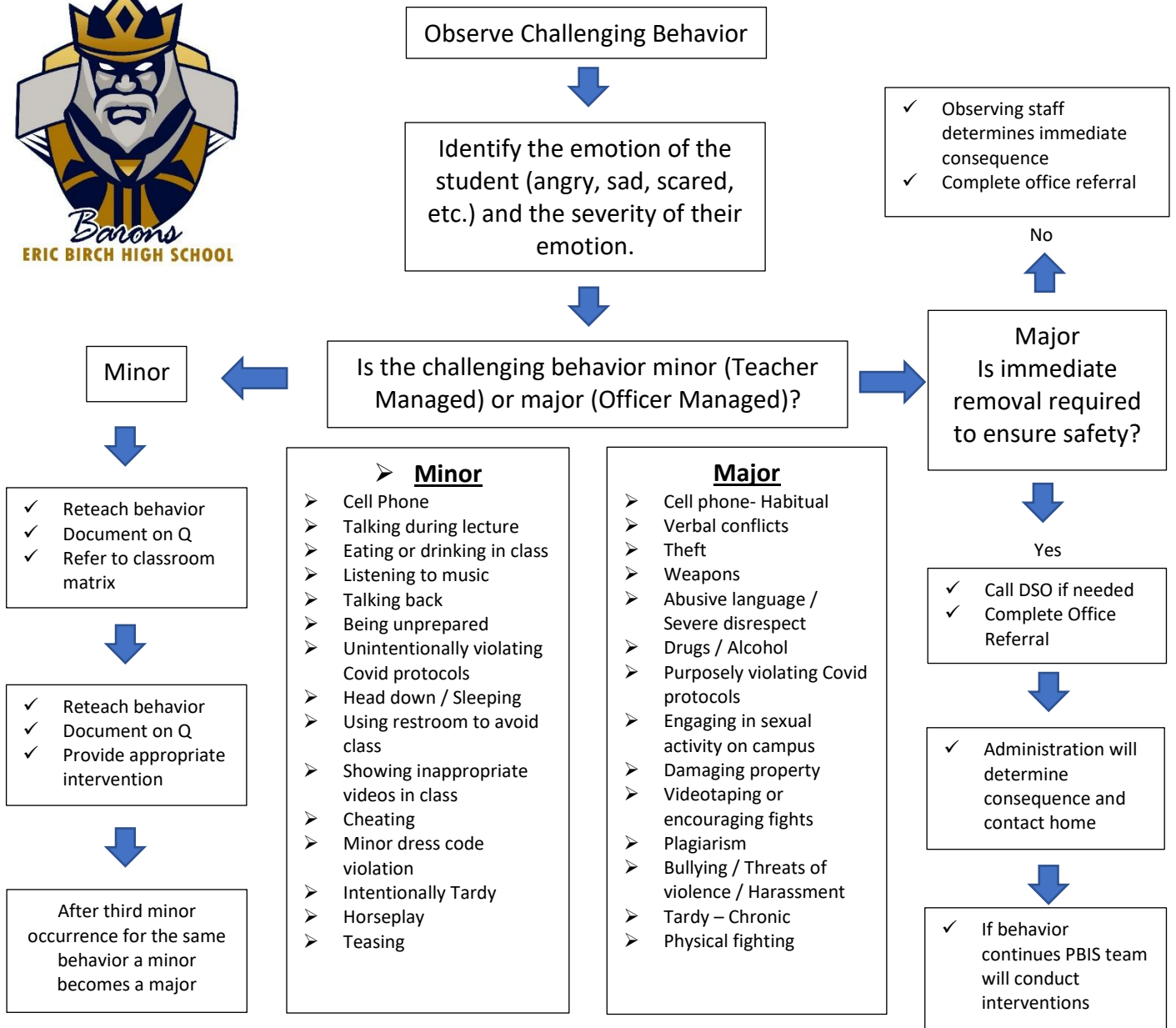


Eric Birch Minor & Major Flow Chart

- Cell Phone

 - Listening to music
 - Talking back
 - Being unprepared
 - Unintentionally violating Covid protocols
 - Head down / Sleeping

 - Showing inappropriate videos in class
 - Cheating
 - Minor dress code violation
 - Intentionally Tardy

- Cell phone- Habitual
 - Verbal conflicts
 - Theft
 - Weapons
 - Abusive language / Severe disrespect
 - Drugs / Alcohol
 - Purposely violating Covid protocols
 - Engaging in sexual activity on campus
 - Damaging property
 - Videotaping or encouraging fights
 - Plagiarism
 - Bullying / Threats of violence / Harassment
 - Tardy – Chronic
 - Physical fighting

Notes on Minors

Record a Minor when a student does not respond to pre-correction, redirection, or cues.

When a Minor occurs take concrete action to correct the behavior and document in Q Visits.

When corrective action works, document as well. It may help in the future. You can **EDIT** Q Visits.
