FUSD buses travel approximately 5,244 miles daily to transport an average of 2,662 students. In the 2022-2023 school year, buses transported students to 947 field trips, covering 79,818 miles.



NEW FOUNDATIONS ENDLESS POSSIBILITIES

In November 2023 FUSD broke ground on our new Middle School, located at Citrus and Casa Grande.

This school will span more than 150,000 square feet and house up to 1,200 students. It is scheduled to open in Winter 2025.
