

# Notice of Virtual Public Hearings

## on Proposed Establishment of Trustee Area Elections for Fontana Unified School District

When any proposal is made to establish trustee areas, rearrange the boundaries of trustee areas, or increase to seven or decrease to five the number of members of a governing board, the County Committee on School District Organization ("County Committee") shall call and conduct at least one public hearing in the district on the matter (Education Code section 5019).

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that at the County Committee will conduct its public hearings under the provisions for virtual meetings authorized by Assembly Bill (AB) 361.

The purpose of this hearing, pursuant to Education Code Section 35720.5, is for the County Committee to hear public comment on the proposed establishment of By-Trustee Area elections of Governing Board Members for the **Fontana Unified School District** ("District"). The current method is At-Large elections. If by resolution the County Committee grants the District's request to change its method of election, the County Committee will conduct a second public hearing to hear public comment on waiving the election requirements to establish trustee election areas as authorized by Senate Bill (SB) 442 that became effective January 1, 2022.

TAKE FURTHER NOTICE that County Committee will convene a public hearing at the date, time and manner stated below to receive public comment on the plan by Fontana Unified School District **to change the manner in which members of the Governing Board are elected**. After the public hearing, the County Committee may act to approve or deny the district's plan.

PLEASE TAKE FURTHER NOTICE that if the County Committee approves the District's plan to change its method of election, the County Committee will immediately convene a second public hearing to hear public comment on waiving the election requirements to establish trustee election areas as authorized by Senate Bill (SB) 442 that became effective January 1, 2022. After the public hearing, the County Committee may act to approve or deny the district's election waiver request.


