

Obituary - Janalee Anderson

Janalee Anderson died at Kaiser Permanente Medical Center on Wednesday, May 8, 2013 of congestive heart failure.

Born July 20, 1942 in Indianapolis, Indiana to Richard and Marion Fox, she was 70 years of age. Janalee was brought to Fontana from Indianapolis at age 5. She attended West Randall Elementary School and Fontana Junior High and graduated from Fontana High School with the class of 1960. She remained a Fontana resident until seven years ago, when she moved to Rancho Cucamonga. During her working life, she was a school bus driver. She worked for the Fontana Unified School District for 12 years from 1968 to 1980, when she retired. During that time she was named "Bus Driver of the Year" twice. She was a team mother and supported Pop Warner Football. She was a member of the Big Horn Mountain Man Club and was awarded the title of "Top Female Shooter and Hatchet Thrower."

Janalee was preceded in death by her husband of 38 years, Raymond Anderson, and her son, Robert Anderson. She will be missed by her son Ronald Anderson of Fontana and brother Larry Fox of Pagosa Springs, Colorado.
