 - o Autobiography
 - o Community Services Essay
- Headshot picture
- Contact Information
- Finalists must attend an interview.
- Finalists must attend a one-hour orientation session.
- Finalists must attend Culmination Event–Saturday, May 13, 2023
- Completed application package must be postmarked no later than February 21, 2023
- Intent to pursue a degree from an accredited four-year College or University.

How has your most meaningful achievements (in service and volunteerism) related to the field of study you plan to pursue and your future goals?
