Eat breakfast, lunch, dinner, & snacks the days preceding the blood drive. Hydrate, Hydrate, Hydrate!

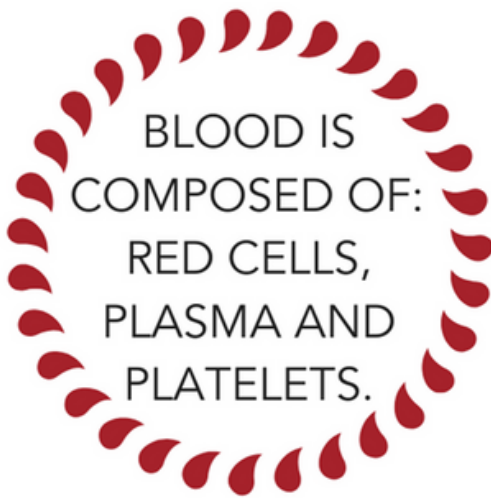
Who shouldn't donate?
