**DETAILS:** Dolores Huerta International Academy will launch with classes in kindergarten through third

grade, 12 classroom teachers and a teacher on special assignment. Grade four will be added

in 2017-18 and grade five in 2018-19.

Under a rigorous, dual-language curriculum, students in kindergarten and first grade will receive 90 percent of their instruction in Spanish and 10 percent in English. As they progress through the grades, the percentage of English instruction will grow until lessons balance

equally between English and Spanish in fifth grade.

The Pre-International Baccalaureate (IB) program will provide K-5 students with a rigorous course of study to prepare them for enrollment in high school IB programs, which feature
