School Police Officer Rescues Choking Infant

Fontana, California:

On Wednesday, October 25, at 6:30 pm, at Maple Elementary School, police officer Jon MacMillan was participating in a Trunk or Treat school activity when Ms. Yesima Guerro requested emergency assistance for her unconscious 9-month-old child. Ms. Guerro told Officer MacMillan her daughter was choking on an object and could not breathe. Officer MacMillan performed first-aid techniques on the child, which dislodged the object allowing the child to breathe normally and regain consciousness. Emergency medical services arrived and evaluated the child's condition. She is expected to recover.

The Fontana Unified School District is committed to providing a safe environment for all students, staff, and visitors to our campuses. Chief Martin J. Sissac said, "I'm relieved and glad Ms. Guerro's daughter is expected to recover. Officer Macmillan prevented a tragedy last night and I commend him for his timely response and first-aid actions. We are proud of Officer Macmillan." Officer MacMillan is a 7-year veteran with the Fontana School Police Department.
