Required Software for Student Devices

Students will need to access the Google Chrome or Microsoft Edge web browser from their **FUSD device**.

Note: These instructions are for MAP tests proctored by a teacher who is not in the same physical space as the student.

How to Take a MAP Assessment

1. Open the Google Chrome or Microsoft Edge internet browser.
2. Go to the [FUSD Student web page](#), click **ClassLink**, then students enter the same credentials that are used to log into their FUSD device. Click the **Sign In** button, then click the **MAP REMOTE TESTING** icon from the ClassLink LaunchPad.



3. From the **MAP login** screen, enter the following information:
 - a. In the field under *Session Name*, students enter the session name provided by their teacher. (Teachers can provide the *Session Name* through Microsoft Teams.)
 - b. In the *Session Password* field, students enter the session password provided by their teacher. (Teachers can provide the *Session Password* through Microsoft Teams.)
4. Click the blue arrow to go to the next screen
5. From the **sign-in** screen, choose your name and test from the lists, then click the blue arrow.
6. On the next screen, if your name and other information are correct, then click the **Yes** button. Let the teacher know through Microsoft Teams if your name or other information are **not** correct.
7. Once the teacher confirms your test, your test will begin. **Remember:** *Your teacher will use the results from this test to help you learn, so do your best, but do not spend too much time on any one question.*
