

Bio-Animatronics HEALTH SCIENCE AND MEDICAL TECHNOLOGY

What do you get when combining robotics, anatomy, and mechatronics? An electro-mechanically animated lifelike figure that can easily be mistaken for a real human. In partnership with

Garner Holt Education, the nation's leading animatronics production company, FoHi is excited to offer students in this pathway access to the brand new, state-of-the-art, "Education Through Imagination" bio-animatronics laboratory. By studying human anatomy, body movement and neuro-prosthetics, students in this pathway will receive a full, comprehensive STEAM experience by incorporating robotics with engineering machines, laser cutters, and 3D printers to design their own life-like models, including artificial hands, arms and legs.

Fire Technology PUBLIC SERVICE

Climb the ladder to an exciting future in fire. This pathway's wide array of local industry partners, including local fire station crews and medical professionals, exposes students to everyday life in the firefighting industry. Fire students utilize teamwork and critical thinking while learning emergency response protocol training.



Multimedia Design ARTS, MEDIA AND ENTERTAINMENT

Master the art of storytelling through design in the Multimedia Design pathway. This pathway features a wide-variety of study areas including graphic design, video/TV production, photography, journalism and presentation skills, and video/photo editing.



Law Enforcement PUBLIC SERVICE

Lay down the law! This pathway is for students interested in a career in law enforcement or a related field in the criminal justice system. Law Enforcement students are set for success in any future endeavor through job shadowing opportunities with local industry partners, including the Fontana Police Departments, California Highway Patrol, and the Sheriff's Department.



Cabinetry, Millwork and Woodworking BUILDING AND CONSTRUCTION TRADES

If you have a knack for building and an eye for design, the Cabinetry, Millwork and Woodworking pathway is for you. In this pathway, students acquire the basic knowledge and skills used in furniture construction, cabinetmaking, and the construction process.

Spark your future in welding! This pathway provides students with exposure to the operation, standards, and current practices in the field of welding and fabrication. Students in this pathway have the opportunity to earn certifications from the American Welding Society (AWS) and can test for welding certifications for advanced welding employment through FoHi's accredited welding testing facility.



Production and Managerial Arts ARTS, MEDIA AND ENTERTAINMENT

Lights, camera, action! The Production and Managerial Arts pathway gives students the opportunity to become versed in on-stage and behind-the-scenes workings of theater. This pathway gets students in the door (or shop) to get on track to work towards certifications and admittance into the International Alliance of Theatrical Stage Employees (IATSE).
