

FUSD Spectator Safety Protocols

Reminders & Updates

SAFETY SCREENING & ENTRY

- All spectators will enter through a security checkpoint.
- Bags and IDs will be screened by law enforcement and/or District Safety Officers.
- Please allow for extra time for screening.

BAG POLICY

<u>Approved Bags</u>

- Clutch or purse no larger than 4.5" x 6.5".
- Clear plastic bags no larger than 12" x 6" x 12".
- Diaper bags must be accompanied by a child.
- No student backpacks allowed

EXPECTED SPECTATOR BEHAVIOR

All attendees are expected to demonstrate good sportsmanship at all times. Verbal abuse, harassment or any disruptive behavior will not be tolerated. Those that do not adhere to the FUSD Spectator Code of Conduct will be removed, without refund, from the premises immediately.

Additional Information

NO RE-ENTRY

- Only factory sealed plastic bottles containing water (up to 1 liter in size) will be permitted inside the event.
- No outside food or drinks permitted.
- No coolers
- No skateboards or scooters
- No smoking or tobacco products, including vapes and e-cigarettes.

STUDENT IDENTIFICATION

- Upon entry, all high school aged students are required to show valid student ID – either physical card or digital.
- Only students of the host school will be allowed on the home side of the stadium.

environment.
